The training will take place in Brussels over 1.5 days, on 5 and 6 March 2025. The sessions will focus on five legislative instruments: the revised Schengen Borders Code, the Screening Regulation, the Asylum Procedures Regulation, the Return Border Procedures Regulation, and the Crisis Regulation. With the Pact on Migration and Asylum approved in 2024, the discussion has already shifted toward its implementation. This training aims to provide an in-depth analysis of the content and likely impact of the five legislative instruments within the Pact. It will also explore the different ways in which the Pact instruments can be operationalised in practice and address key challenges and risks arising during the implementation phase.
